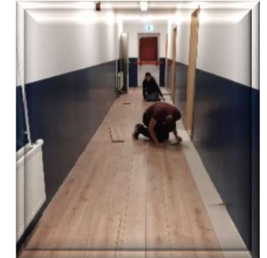

for a year. She has invited and come to church with three other ladies who are also working in Iceland, doing the same thing she is.
