Hello from Iceland! I am William Weimer and am studying, online, at Virginia Baptist College in order to prepare for and eventually join the ministry. Because I believe that God has called me into the ministry, specifically as a missionary (Psalm 96:3), my father suggested that I write this prayer letter.



Sumarbúðir (Summer Camp) 2018: Live the Life! Camp this year will focus on teaching about the importance of life choices: Understanding that you will be somewhere forever, Deciding to make your life have an eternal impact on others, Understanding that knowing God and making Him known to others is truly life. Please prayerfully consider sponsoring a child to go to camp. The cost is 150 dollars per child, and we expect 40 children and 15 staffers to attend camp. Our camp is a traditional 6-day camp from Monday – Saturday, July 23 – 28.

Please Pray! From experience, I can firmly state that his time of year is when we see a majority of children trust Christ. Unfortunately, it is also one of the most stressful times of year; Satan constantly tries and is trying to disrupt the work that God will do during summer camp. Please pray that God would give wisdom, patience, and encouragement to those who are involved or will be involved in this truly life-changing outreach.

International English Ministry: To the right is a picture of this growing outreach. We have recently seen an increase in the attendance level of this service; part of this increase is due to a substantial number of attenders who now commute (for 30 minutes) from the capitol every Sunday. In fact, a young man, one of these commuters, professed to have trusted Christ, just this Sunday (5/13). This ministry has also increased because one of our members recently got married! Brother Pawel from Poland, who has been attending our church for nearly a year, married Mrs. Sylwia this past month. Pray that God would protect their new family as they are an example to the entire country of Iceland as to a godly marriage and family. While God has clearly been blessing the international ministry, it has some issues, specifically in the area of communication. Please pray that these foreigners who have language difficulties will understand the messages being preached.



Children's Ministry: Since God provided our church with a bus, we have seen well over a 100% increase in child attendance. Part of that increase includes kindergarteners which are taught by Bjartmey, one of our most faithful church members, and my brother, Clayton. For those of you who sacrificed in order for us to have a church vehicle, thank you. You have no idea what an amazing impact the bus has had on our ministry.
