**Construction/Camp preparation**: After the construction team left 3 weeks ago I have been able to paint and install lights in all rooms and they are ready for summer camp. The team installed 231 sheets of drywall and mudded much. I was able to finish mudding, sanding, and painting last week. The floors are the only item that we were not able

to complete. I was able to paint them, so the concrete dust does not get on the kids as they sleep in the rooms. Morningside Baptist Church sent us an offering towards completing the floors.
