Crazy busy! By way of review: January — March we did much preparation and planning for our new missionary family, the Sears. In May, Vicki and I went to the States to be with Rosa and William for Rosa's graduation and William's ordination. Plus, we did some wedding planning for Rosa. We landed in Iceland and went straight to the hospital to be by the side of a member passing from cancer.

He had been diagnosed just this January. Instead of spending the week before camp doing final preparations and training staff, we rearranged the building for a funeral. After the funeral, we propelled into summer camp week. At camp's end, we had a community outreach that saw over a hundred visits. Then we had another perspective missionary couple, the Larson family, come for a survey trip. They stayed a week with us. Then a 35-person group (**photo above**) came on a mission trip from Morningside Baptist Church in Greenville, SC, with Pastor Crockett and Assistant Pastor Webb. Amazingly, the group completed over sixty projects/tasks. There was much planning and work in making their trip successful. I have a good team helping here. With the large group camping in the church, we changed our program on

Sunday to be a Family Day outreach. More than one hundred people visited. As I write this letter, we are just beginning to get our house and church in order again. It has been back-to-back triathlons. Thankfully, souls trusted Jesus and were baptized. We had the opportunity to distribute Gospel tracts to many homes this summer. All of the above was in addition to our normal weekly services and outreach. **Photo right**: A group of precious souls seeking asylum in Iceland from Venezuela do not speak English. Though a blessing to have them here, ministering to them is challenging. We also have a large group from Ukraine. God is bringing the world to us.
