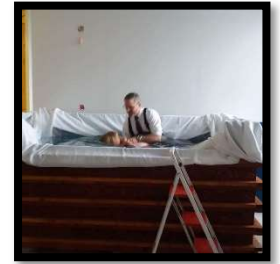




THE NORTHERN LIGHT ICELAND NEWS THE WEIMER FAMILY SINCE 1999

I will share more about this after they come for a visit. We are also gearing up for a construction team to come in six months to tile and build doors. My prayer request is to complete the building project by the end of 2020 when I am 50 years old. We pray churches will come and help us with this goal.

2018 has seen several saved and baptized! We are thankful for the growth. Please pray for leadership to grow from within the church. With more people comes more responsibility to minister. The international church has averaged 35, and our Icelandic services 45 during August. Most of our English church is immigrants from many different countries. Our Icelandic service is mostly children and teens through our bus ministry. Imagine our joy when a mother and father of two new children came to church services yesterday! Please pray for the adults, especially the parents of the children whom we currently pick up in the bus ministry. The photos below are from August. Left photo is our bus ministry when we rejoiced to have 54! The right photo is of our international English with 45 in attendance. It is an honor to serve the Lord in Iceland. We intend to stay faithful until the work is finished. That includes: church planted and in national's hands, Bible translated, curriculum from K to college, music and song book, Christian school, Bible dictionary, commentaries, and other study tools...and more! The work will take a lifetime, and we have chosen to give to the Lord our lives for this purpose. On behalf of my family and the country of Iceland, we thank you for praying and supporting the work in Iceland.
