Thank you for praying! **Second Leg: July, SUMMER CAMP:** Summer camp saw seven decisions for salvation and many other decisions to daily live for the Lord. Mary Slessor was our missionary story. Each day the children memorized Bible verses, read the Bible, heard preaching, had a Bible review challenge, and ended the day with song, prayer, and testimonies. The theme was "Faith Will Overcome." I used the armor of God in Ephesians to teach them how to win in life's battles and how to overcome by faith. They learned that Salvation is not only that they get to go to heaven, but also that Jesus lives in the saved to provide strength, guidance, and ultimately, power to overcome by His faith.



Our summer camp is not a day-camp. We camp in the church for six days and nights while providing meals and activities. The end of camp is an outreach to the friends and families of all the kids who attend camp. It concludes with a ceremony as we give awards to teams and individuals. For the first time, this year every single child had a parent attend. Several had many family



members and friends attend. Everyone heard the gospel of Jesus Christ during that service. In the photo to the left, you see the children who attended camp standing in front and their parents. This was a special blessing! **Third Leg: July, 42-PERSON TEAM:** Morningside Baptist Church sent a 42-person team of

high schoolers and college young adults to help do projects and to distribute literature to the homes in the six towns surrounding our church. We reached out to over 5,300 homes. The team also helped with many other projects. It would not be possible to highlight each of them. Sufficient to say, they accomplished over thirty big projects that were on my list to do this summer. Wow, were they hard workers! These feeble things called words fall woefully short of expressing gratitude for this team of young people. They sang the gospel hymns like an angel choir together. (Photo right) Hope was renewed in my heart as I saw in them a people who want, more than anything, to serve Jesus and to see the lost saved. Many of the youth shared that they made decisions for the Lord here in Iceland. Some shared a burden to pray about serving as a missionary in Iceland. Please pray for these young
