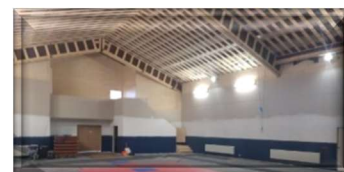
Saying "Goodbye" Yunis, a young lady from the Philippines has been with us for a little over a year but is leaving in July to work in another country. She is a very godly young lady and has been a blessing to the church.

She works as an Au Pair. Saying "Goodbye" is never fun! The photos above were taken in June of those attending the English-speaking international church in which we minister to temporary workers from other countries and immigrants who have not fully integrated into society by learning Icelandic. Please pray for those who have not yet been saved as well as for the growth of those who are saved. **I would not call a post-COVID lockdown, a return to "normal,"** however, we are holding services regularly again. Summertime is always a time where fewer people attend church, especially the children in the bus ministry. We have averaged 25 in the youth church/bus ministry since things opened back up. I have mentioned this often in my prayer letters, but please pray for these young people in Iceland. There are tremendous cultural pressures and opposition to believe the Bible. Jesus loves all the children of the world, but the world is in strong opposition to the kids hearing of Jesus and His love for them. Thank you for praying for them. The photos on the right were taken in June of this ministry keyed to reaching out to the Icelandic speaking nationals. **Thankfully, we have also had some adults attending** our afternoon service, which is from 2 – 4:30 Sundays. Thank you for praying for the adults to come to know the Lord and to grow in Him. For the first hour of our afternoon services, I am with the adults, and then from 3 – 4:30, I have the 4th, 5th, and 6th graders. In addition to services being back to "normal," **we are also allowed to visit once again on visitation.** I enjoyed seeing everybody over the past two weeks. Numbers have gone up also in attendance, as expected, with bus visitation; that is simply how bus ministry works as one reaches out



to minister to the children of unbelievers. Through each and every week, we hold seven services. I prepare for six lessons each week, and Vicki has the lady's Bible study. Vicki and my three kids also prepare lessons for each age group and are full-time help during our times of ministry. Thank you for praying for us as we prepare lessons and seek to train them in the Scriptures. **Photo left is of the young adults** who came to an activity of playing horse-

shoes, soccer, and a hike up a dormant volcano call ThorBjorg by the Blue Lagoon. There is also a small pine forest at this sight. We don't have many trees in our "neck of the woods." It was wonderful to see them enjoying fellowship in Jesus as a peer group. It sure blessed mine and Vicki's hearts to be part of this. Thank you for praying for our young adult group in Iceland. **Trowell and Sword in hand:** As we continue the ministry of the Word to those living in our community, I am also focused on the goal of finishing the building project by the year's end. The project was started in 1994, 26 years ago by a body of believers from the USA serving on the Naval Air Station of Keflavik, who were members of FBC Njardvik. At the closing of the base in 2006, after 12 years of drawdown, the building was only 30% constructed on the inside, and the exterior shell of the building was only 70% completed. God has performed a miracle over the past 14 years, and we are on the last room. Thank you for praying for both the provisions to complete this by year's end, as well as the wisdom and laborers for the tasks ahead as we build a place for God's people to gather and reach the world through Iceland. The photo right shows the progress as of this week on the last room. Thank you for praying that we are able to finish this before December this year. Thank you for praying for the financial need as well as need for laborers. We are building without any debt as God provides.
