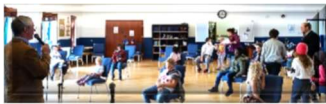

With the **COVID** regulations in Iceland, we constantly have to clean much more than before. I am thankful for the two families that came to clean (Photo left). Vicki and I were not even there! I am so blessed to see people stand up and take an interest in the ministry. We have seen many people in our ministry both come to faith and grow in faith this year. One lady from the Phillipians joined the church! Thankfully, we are able to hold all of our regular



services. The government did change the rules this week, and we had to move our chairs apart again. Here, like everywhere, the rules seem to change by the minute. Thank you for praying for our ministries in Icelandic for the nationals as well as our ministries in English for immigrants and temporary workers in Iceland. Having **all my kids home due to COVID** closing colleges has allowed the five of us to work together in our outreach and discipleship. God gave my family this promise through Vicki having her Bible devotions: Leviticus 26:8 “And five of you shall chase an hundred, and an hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight: and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword.” As we are in a spiritual battle in a heathen culture, this promise sure gave all of us some encouragement. **Sadly**, on Wednesday the 12th of August, we said goodbye to Rosa as she returns a sophomore to college seeking to attain a B.A. in Criminal Law. Clayton will continue his courses with PCC via distance learning. He is seeking a B.A. in Education, Math & Science, and is almost a Junior. He wants to teach in our Christian School that we hope to establish in the coming years. William is a senior and is double majoring seeking to attain both a B.A. in Pastoral/Missions as well as a B.S. in Secondary Education, with mathematics focus. He is living here in Iceland with us taking classes online via Veritas Baptist College. William fills the pulpit for me, teaches Sunday school, and does much more like a faithful missionary. I am blessed my kids are all saved and seek to serve Jesus in our mission work in Iceland. Vicki helps full time in the ministry. She is a missionary herself. She is our pianist and has 20 or more hats of responsibility she faithfully wears as she labors for Jesus alongside me. I am blessed to have married a missionary! **We have had several visitors** over the past month come to each service. We are very blessed to have the opportunity to share God’s Word with



them. The photo left is our bus ministry/youth church. We have parents visiting more recently than in years past. I had a young man in 5th grade in my class who came for the second time yesterday.
