The 18-passenger mini-bus is on the move for Jesus! What a blessing to see boys and girls, with some parents, coming to church each week. These are the children who will be able to attend our summer camp in July. We have been praying for them, teaching them, and building relationships with them since June last year when the bus ministry got up-and-running. Several of the children have made decisions to trust Jesus as their personal Savior. Several are thinking about it very much! We begin with no knowledge at all about God, or the Bible, and

work up from there. It is not a quick process. We patiently seek to see them understand the Gospel and wait for the Lord to bring them to a decision. It is hard to wait for the fruit, but every good farmer understands that seeds planted take time to bear fruit. In the photo, top left, from April 1^{st} we had 34 on the bus; that is two trips! The camp theme is "**Live the Life**" and will emphasize 4 truths: You will be somewhere

forever; your life matters and is a gift from God; your life is supposed to be a light to give life; your life should make an impact for God in this life and have an eternal impact. **My three children are such a help in the ministry**. William is in the photo with pie in his face, as he took one for the team for a church promotion to boost attendance. He is finishing his first year in Bible College online at Virginia Baptist College. Clayton will be leaving back to PCC in August. He has worked hard to pay off his school debt and save money to go back to school. I am very proud of him. Rosa is finishing her junior year in high school,



and she is very much looking forward to getting out of school next year! She might graduate in December. Vicki has a regular Bible study with a young lady in our church, Bjartmey who is really growing in the Lord. Vicki also teaches English to a lady from Ghana with a goal to teach her Icelandic later. She has never learned to read or write her own language. It is a blessing to see an adult learning to read for the first time.
