learn the Icelandic language. Our goal is to assimilate all into the Icelandic ministry, specifically those who intend to stay permanently in Iceland. God has given us some new attenders that are my son William and John from Nepal, to start a prayer time! William is also leading a Bible study with John. John has been such a blessing to bring his brother and several friends to church. Some are now attending faithfully. Most still need to be saved, but God is working in their hearts. Please pray for them. Our men's prayer meeting and Bible study is seeing 10 to 12 in attendance each Friday night. Each man has brought a devotion before the prayer time, and it has been such a blessing to see how they prepare a lesson. This is a big step for the church to be taking, as the members within take the initiative to grow.



God provides a family car: As you saw in October, our family car finally died from terminal rust and other internal damage of moving parts. It put us in quite a jam. Vicki can't drive the bus without a CDL. God put it in the heart of a former member of FBC to give us a very big love offering in December; we were able to purchase a Ford Fiesta, new, and under warranty for 3 years. **Snow upon Snow:** It has been quite a cold and snowy winter; even for Iceland. We woke up on Sunday to the drift shown in the photo to the right, quite a feat to dig through it to get to church. Then a blizzard came, and we had to cancel our afternoon Icelandic services.
