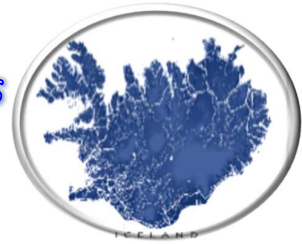




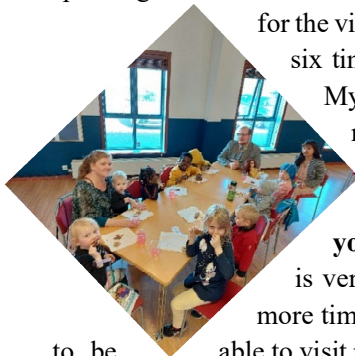

Reporting April - May, 2022

April – May 2022: We stayed busy in our outreach over the past month. Beyond our promotions to encourage visitors, our people have been excited about bringing visitors to church every week in the Icelandic-speaking ministry and the English services. God brought us people from two new countries, Venezuela and Ethiopia, besides visitors from Iceland. We also had U.S. military members come for a visit during their temporary duty in Iceland. We also have two professional American soccer players attending our services who play for an Iceland team. Also, Jenn, a lady from the Philippines, led another lady to Christ. I baptized her on Sunday, May 22nd. (Photo below). We also had seventeen visitors come to our services that same day to both the English and Icelandic speaking ministries. **Thank you for praying** for services in both languages,



for the visitors, and for our follow-up on them. I prepare and teach six times each week, three in Icelandic and three in English.

My wife, Vicki, also is very involved and busy in these ministries. The photo to the left is of a group of children

in our bus ministry. One daughter brought her mother and three other guests. On June 24 – 25th we will have a community outreach carnival with hotdogs, games, and fun. **Thank**

you for praying that we have good weather and lots of visitors. Because summer in Iceland

is very short, we have much to do both in church and personal work. Each summer, we spend more time visiting homes. For the past two years, COVID has hindered that, but we are encouraged

to be able to visit more this summer. I started painting the roof at the church last year. Due to the lack of good weather, I only finished priming half of it. **Thank you for praying** for me as I replace 7,000 screws, as well as prime

and paint the other half and then paint the entire 13,000-square-foot roof. On a personal note: I also need to replace the roof of my garage at home. My house is concrete and very cracked, which facilitates water leaking into our house. I

have to build scaffolding around the house, do concrete repairs, and then paint the entire house. **Thank you for praying**

for us as we maintain our regularly scheduled services, do outreach, and attempt to do these additional projects during the short summertime in Iceland. We have wanted to start a Christian school for over 15 years. In May, Vicki finished

her 3-year journey to receive her master's degree in Christian education. During that time, she did not neglect to be my helpmeet in the ministry for a moment! **Thank you for praying** for her as she cuts through the red tape of the

government to receive all the certification and approval we need. I have been working on getting the building up to code

and have fulfilled all major requirements, with only minor things to finish. **Thank**

you for praying for this need for a Christian school. As I mentioned in my previous letter, August 24th will mark our 23rd year serving in Iceland. The photo

to the left was taken in August 1999, just before we left the USA for Iceland. The photo on the right is us now. We rejoice over the thousands of souls who have

heard the gospel and the hundreds who have trusted Jesus as their personal Savior over those years. We rejoice over the souls saved through our ministry who serve

alongside us in Iceland. We rejoice over the souls who have come to Iceland from over 35 different countries, have been saved, and have returned to their homes to continue to serve the Lord in their

local churches. It has been a battle, but it has been a blessing. Anything we have accomplished has been only accomplished by God working in and through us. To Jesus be all glory, honor, and blessing both now and forever. Amen! **Thank you for praying** for our continued service to Christ Jesus in Iceland. **Thank you also for praying** that God would send laborers to help in the ministries the Lord has established through us in Iceland.
