Summer is upon us: To celebrate the completion of the building project, we are having a Homecoming celebration on June 25 - 27. This year marks 30 years since the groundbreaking of the church building. When the military base closed, we received the building project, a 13,000-square-foot building that was only 30% done, with nearly every member leaving Iceland. We have invited the twenty churches and former members who helped us build to come back to Iceland and rejoice with us as we formally dedicate the completed building. It has been a long journey. We expect over sixty people from the States and many from our community. Thank you for praying as we hope to see this Homecoming used by God to encourage believers and reach souls with the Gospel of Christ in Iceland.

Icelandic ministry: Because seeing adults attend has proven difficult, I was pleased to see eleven attend in the adult ministry last week. Children and teens usually attend until they are 14 years old when society pressures them to be confirmed into the State Church. We have grown accustomed to losing nearly everybody after confirmation. Though we have tried different approaches over the years, this remains difficult to overcome. Hence, I was pleasantly surprised to see those eleven adults. The children's ministry has seen good attendance, averaging over thirty since our last letter.



Summer camp: July 22-29 will be our annual summer camp. We are looking for sponsors to send kids to camp. These are the children we have been teaching, praying for, and bringing to church throughout the past twelve months. Many of them come to camp and make life-changing decisions. English-speaking ministry: The English-speaking ministry is our transient ministry as we have people coming to Iceland to work, vacation, and visit. For the most part, this group of people is not permanent in Iceland. It is similar to a military ministry overseas. We have even had some military members stationed here for a few months over the past year. We rejoice to have many countries who attend our English-speaking ministry. Our average in this ministry has been thirty five since our last letter. We did have one baptism in May. One of our teenagers from Spain trusted the Lord in summer camp a few years ago and has been helping in our church faithfully for quite some time. He had heard about baptism many times, and we were so happy to hear that he wanted to be baptized
