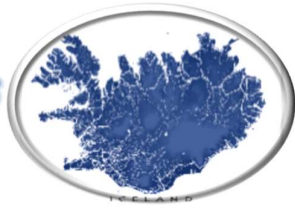




# The Northern Light Iceland News

Reporting March – April, 2022



We packed quite a bit into March and April. (See photo left of March 27.) **It gives me great joy to see our people inviting guests each week**, making us rarely go a week without a guest. Last Sunday, April 17, ten visitors came, three of whom were military members on Temporary Duty Assignment in Iceland. Many who regularly attend are growing spiritually, and some are

waiting to be baptized as well. Though most people in the photo will only be in Iceland for a year or less working, we thank God for the opportunity to touch lives **from over 20 different countries**. The photo to the right is of our ministry to the Icelandic-speaking community. You may notice some crossover in the pictures because some who attend the English church also help in the Icelandic outreach. We are blessed to have an open door to reach out to these precious souls for whom Christ died, but as we see open doors for outreach, we also experience adversity. “For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and **there are many adversaries**” (1 Corinthians 16:9). As modernism, socialism, Darwinism, and humanism are deeply established in this progressive culture, our ideologic challenge is not appreciated. and culture with the power of God’s Word. The photo to the left is of our workers and the construction team that came from Greater Vision Baptist Church. That Sunday, March 27, was William’s last Sunday with us in Iceland. It was a joy to see our workers come together to have fellowship after serving all day at church. I am so proud of their outpouring of love and sacrifice to the team that came from Kentucky to help me build. The construction team from GVBC was able to help me **put in over 5,000 square feet of drywall on ceilings**. With only 4 ½ workdays, it was a miracle that we could accomplish what we did. The team brought me to the one-yard line. I have only a small job to finish the required tasks. The inspectors will come soon, and I am confident they will be pleasantly surprised. I am thankful for the time sacrificed and



resources to accomplish this great task! If I am not mistaken, this is the 20<sup>th</sup> team to come and help us since 2008. This 13,000 square foot building project was only 30% finished in 2006 when it was left to us by the military church. The last project is to purchase and install fourteen small windows in the seven classrooms and one window in the main auditorium. This construction is truly a miracle of God, given our other outreaches in the church plant, Bible translation work, summer camp, bus ministry, and other outreach programs. God has given us grace also to complete this great task given to us sixteen years ago. **Thank you for praying for us as we press forward in ministry and put the finishing touches on the building.** Our second-oldest, William (23), is finishing two bachelor’s degrees. After interning at our home church, Kerwin Baptist, he will complete one degree this summer. He did his course studies online with Veritas Baptist College. Then, after the summer, he will be student teaching to complete his education B.S. degree. With his leaving, Vicki and I are experiencing an empty nest. It is bizarre. Thank you for praying for him and us as we press forward to do God’s Will. Thank you for your faithful prayers and support! There are many personal and ministry needs; we trust the Lord to touch hearts as we focus on serving Him!



Thank you for praying! August 23<sup>rd</sup> will mark our 23<sup>rd</sup> year in Iceland as missionaries. It has been quite the journey. This year marks my 52<sup>nd</sup> year on the earth and my 31<sup>st</sup> year since trusting Jesus to save me. I was 21 years old serving in Iceland with the USAF when Jesus gave me eternal life and a purpose for living. I am forever grateful. I could never repay Him enough.
