The ministry to Icelandic speaking Nationals: We are gearing up for our summer camp this July 8 – 13. Because our number of workers is down, we are feeling the crunch for getting things ready for camp. Thank you for praying about this. The theme for camp is “Overcoming.” I John 5:4 “This is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.” We camp out in

the church for six days providing meals, housing, and an intense Bible-based program. At the end of our summer camp we have a community outreach and awards ceremony at the church. We rent inflatables, have carnival games, and food & fun for all family members of the children who attended camp. The goal is to get the gospel into as many hearts as possible. I am trusting the Lord to provide the needs for this project.
