In May, we held a carnival at the church with bounce houses, carnival games, hotdogs, and more. Over 200 people came during the two-day carnival. She has wandered away from the Lord, but God used this outreach program to remind her of something that she had forgotten, Jesus loves her. In addition to the computer, they provided an office chair that allows me to spend lots of time studying without back strain. I was able to purchase both a standing chair and a sitting chair. Oddly, I can do hard labor for ten hours a day easily, but sitting and studying kills my back. Ecclesiastes 12:12 "And further, by these, my son, be admonished: of making many books there is no end; and much study is a weariness of the flesh." Thank God for these tools. Over the past seven days, I have spent more than 30 hours translating. The chairs and computer help so much. Their offering was enough for me to purchase some needed software and books also.
